SUBJECT:-CIVIL DEFENCE LOGO.

Sir,

Consequent to decision taken in the IX Biennial Conference held in October, 1986, States were requested to suggest a design for the Civil Defence Logo. The design sent by Maharashtra was approved with slight modification. The logo was released by the Hon'ble Home Minister Shri L.K. Advani on the 6th May, 2000 at National Civil Defence College, Nagpur.


2. The logo has a bicolour triangle at the Centre of the olive green wreath. The state emblem is at the top of the wreath and the inspiration of Civil Defence सर्व भूत भित्ते रतः finds place at the bottom.

3. Olive green wreath is symbolic of peace and prosperity. Triangle in Vedas indicates safety. State Emblem atop the wreath enhances the status of the State Emblem. Green, Machine-blue, red, white and light blue signify the Civil Defence services viz. Warden Service, Rescue Service, Fire Fighting, First Aid, Rescue and Incident control respectively.

4. One coloured copy of the Civil Defence Logo is enclosed. A Civil Defence Flag is also being designed to give identity to the Civil Defence Organisation. A colour presentation ceremony will be held on special occasion.
