Dear Shri

The VIII Biennial Conference on Home Guards and Civil Defence held in New Delhi in November, 1980, had recommended that unemployed Home Guards and Civil Defence volunteers, after rendering national service for a few years, should be given some weightage for employment in Government services, as an incentive. In pursuance of the above decision, Department of Personnel & A.R. had issued detailed instructions to Central Ministries and Departments on the question of giving preference to Home Guards and Civil Defence volunteers having three years service and requisite training in those posts in Group 'C' and 'D' where such experience would be an added advantage for efficient performance of duties, vide letter No. 14034/5/82-Estt.'D' dated 5.11.1983. The above circular was forwarded to State Governments under this Ministry's letter No. VI-31011/1/81-DGCD(HG) dated 17.1.84 with the request that the State Governments may also consider issuing similar instructions in the matter and that copies of the instructions issued may be forwarded to the Home Ministry. Home Ministry had also issued instructions earlier vide letter No. I-35012/1/81-DGCD dated 10.2.1981, requesting State Governments to provide assistance to unemployed Home Guards in seeking gainful employment on the completion of their term of enrolment. Copies of the above mentioned three circulars are enclosed herewith.

2. May I request you to have appropriate action taken in this regard at the earliest and also to let us know about the action taken.
