Subject: Welfare & Benevolent Funds to Home Guards personnel.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to various queries/correspondence received in this Ministry regarding framing of Rules for Welfare and Benevolent Fund for Home Guards in States/UTs and to say that the State Govts/UT Adms. are competent to frame the State Home Guards Welfare & Benevolent Fund Rules and that no approval is required from this Ministry.

2. However, it is again reiterated that the Rules should be in conformity with the Model Rules circulated vide this Ministry's letter No. VI-14021/16/79-DJGD(HG) dated 15.12.1988, and that the Union Govt. will bear only Rs.7.50 per Home Guard per annum within the authorised strength.

3. This Ministry has no objection regarding payment to enhanced monetary benefits as already intimated vide this Ministry's letter of even number dated 18th December, 1991.
