Sir,

I am directed to refer to this Ministry's letter of even number dated the 20th October, 1987 on the subject noted above and to forward herewith a copy of Model Rules vide Appendix 'A' to this letter on the administration of the Home Guards Welfare & Benevolent Fund to be instituted by Union Territory Administrations who may now frame their own Rules not inconsistent with the above Model Rules. A copy of the same may be sent to this Ministry. Union Territories if any, who have already instituted Home Guards Welfare & Benevolent Fund and have framed their own Rules, may now revise the same in the light of the Model Rules.

2. The pattern of Central financial assistance for the Home Guards Welfare & Benevolent Fund has already been indicated in this Ministry's letter of even number dated 20th October, 1987 (copy enclosed). For the purpose of seeking additional fund in the Home Guards Budget grant of the U.T. Administration for institution of Home Guards Welfare & Benevolent Fund, it may please be ensured that the Fund is duly constituted by the UT Administration and Rules framed for its administration in conformity with the Model Rules in consultation with their Finance Depts. and this Ministry and the same notified in the Gazette. It may also be ensured that Central Government's contribution to the fund

does not exceed Rs. 15.00 per Home Guard per year on the authorised strength of Home Guards as fixed by this Ministry for the various Union Territories.
