Sub:- Payment of washing allowance to Home Guard volunteers when called out for duty/training.


Sir,

The undersigned is directed to say that the proposal for enhancement of Washing Allowance for Home Guard personnel from Rs.12/- to Rs.25/- per month has been accepted by the Government of India and this will be implemented w.e.f. 1st October,2002 in all States/Union Territories.

2. The expenditure involved in payment of this allowance will be met by the calling agency at whose instance the Home Guard volunteers are called out and deployed. Expenditure on payment of washing allowance during training will however be poolable and shareable between the Centre and the State Government as per the existing financial policy.


