**Subject:- Authorisation of Terrycot Uniform in place of Cotton Uniform for Home Guards.**

Sir,

I am directed to say that a Home Guard has been authorized one pair of terrycot uniform (shirt khaki terrycot & pant khaki terrycot) with the life span of 4 years and pair of cotton uniform (shirt khaki cellular & pant khaki drill) with the life span of one year.

2. A proposal to replace the existing one set of cotton uniform with the terrycot uniform for Home Guards was under consideration of this office. The proposal has been considered and after due consideration, it has been decided to authorize another one set of terrycot uniform in place of existing one set of cotton uniform with the life span of 4 years. Now a Home Guard is entitled to only two sets of terrycot uniform. The rate of one set of terrycot uniform will be Rs.270.51(Rupees two hundred seventy and fifty one paise). This office letter No.IV-210212/2003-DGCD(HG) dated 18.3.2004 regarding revision of ceiling cost of uniform items for Home Guards may please be amended accordingly.

3. This issues with the approval of Integrated Finance Division of the Ministry vide their Dy.No.3268/AS&FA(H)/05 dated 16.12.2005.


