
Subject:-Payment of expenditure on deployment of Border Wing
Home Guards with the B.S.F.

Sir,
I am directed to refer to this Ministry's letter of even number dated the 7th June, 1979 and to say that the question of payment of expenditure on deployment of Border Wing Home Guards with the B.S.F. in Punjab, Rajasthan and Gujarat has been considered by this Ministry and it has been decided that the additional expenditure involved in the deployment of the Border Wing Home Guards with the B.S.F. for the duration of their deployment will be borne by this Ministry at 100% and will form part of the Home Guards budget at the Centre. The expenditure on usual pay and allowances of the full time paid officers of the Border Wing Home Guards even during their deployment with the B.S.F. will, however, continue to be shared by the Central and State Governments at 75:25 basis as per existing financial policy. The expenditure will initially be borne by the State Governments concerned and subsequently reimbursed to the State Governments according to the normal practice in regard to other authorised expenditure incurred on raising, training and equipping of Border Wing Home Guards. This re-imbusement of expenditure will be subject to strict observance of the call-up procedure as laid down in this Ministry's letter of even number dated 7th June, 1979 by the State Governments concerned.

2. This issues in consultation with the Integrated Finance Division vide their Dy.No.S-62/80-WR(Fin.III) dated 26-7-1980.
